





FOUNDERS' LETTER




Dear friends of Iris,







RELIEF

The majority of our relief work has necessarily been focused on the province of Cabo Delgado in northern Mozambique. Our Pemba team — made up of 99.5% nationals — has tirelessly faced danger, trauma, overwhelming need, and endless opportunity to share the tangible love and hope of Jesus.

In the midst of the daily challenges of living in and serving a community in need — the pandemic notwithstanding — violent extremism erupted in the



northern part of their province resulting in deluge of people seeking safety in and around Pemba. While the threat of violence being pervasive and the attacks growing more brazen and closer to Pemba, it was the crushing need of the desperate people who fled that weighed heavily on the hearts of our team. And yet, this is what they had laid down their lives for saying,

“Jesus, you are worthy of it all.”

In Pemba alone, over 30,000 internally displaced and extremely needy people were fed every day! In addition to life-saving food, basic supplies, clean water, seeds & farm tools, and audio Bibles were also distributed.




